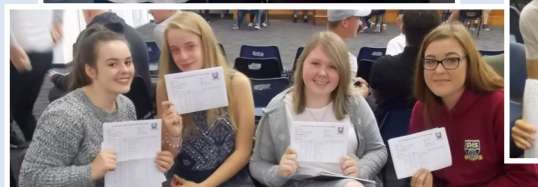
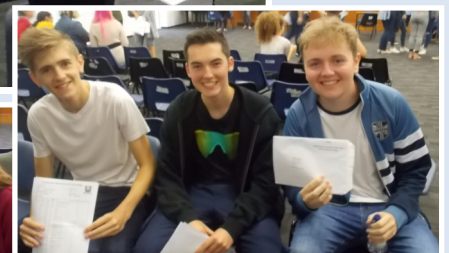
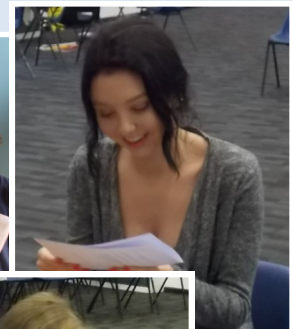

We are proud of our VIth Form A Level students as they have all packed up the contents of their bedrooms and headed off to start the next stage of their education at their chosen universities.

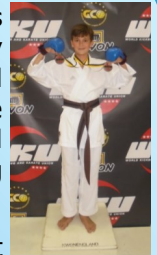
The BTEC results were impressive with almost 70% of all BTEC entries being awarded a Distinction or Distinction*.
