The Stourport VIth Form College Entry Requirements 2019-20:

To ensure students are well placed on courses, the application process will consist of a number of elements:

- written application form;
- one-to-one interview with VIth Form Leaders;
- entry passport - offer made based on student's results, attendance, attitude to learning;
- performance during induction and enrolment in the summer term;
- suitability fortnight at the start of the September term.

External candidates will also have the same entry requirements, along with a reference from their school.

Information from all of the above will be considered when you are offered a conditional place and when that place is confirmed on results day.

General Entry Requirements:

To study on the A Level Pathway at The Stourport VIth Form College, you will need to achieve 5 x Grade 5s or above including English and Mathematics. In addition to these requirements, some individual subjects will request a Grade 6 in their GCSE or facilitating subjects. For example, to study A Level English Literature you will need a Grade 6 in GCSE English Literature. Whereas, Further Mathematics request a Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics. For the Vocational pathway you will need to achieve 5 x Grade 4s or above including English and/or Mathematics. There will also be additional requirements in some Vocational subjects, for example to study BTEC Sport you will need a Grade 5 in Science.

There may be a possibility to re-sit English or Mathematics (not both) if a Grade 3 is achieved in that subject.

All applications will be looked at and offers made on a case by case basis.
